

DESCRIPTION OF INDICATOR

This indicator tracks the percentage of children who are up-to-date with recommended vaccines at their 2nd birthday and at kindergarten entry. Data at 2nd birthday are based on annual retrospective reviews of randomly selected kindergarten immunization records. Data at kindergarten entry include all public and private schools in Orange County.

Why is this Important?

The widespread use of safe, effective onlineod vaccinations is one of the most successful and cost-effective public health interventions. Many serious and once-common childhood infections have been dramatically reduced through routine immunizations. The success of immunization programs depends upon appropriate timing and on a high rate of vaccine acceptance, particularly among parents of young children. Increasing numbers of children with delayed or refused vaccinations may lead to communities that are below the protective level needed to prevent the spread of disease.

Findings


- The percentage of Orange County children with up-to-date vaccinations at kindergarten entry has decreased in the past 10 years, from 92.9% in 2003 to 89.3% in 2012.
- In 2012, 6.3% of under-immunized kindergartners were enrolled on the condition that they would become adequately immunized (conditional enrollment).
- An additional 3% of kindergartner's parents signed a personal belief exemption allowing them to enter kindergarten inadequately immunized.
- Some school districts within the county are below 85% vaccination coverage at kindergarten entry.
- The percent of Orange County children with up-to-date immunizations at their 2nd birthday was 75.7% in 2012, an increase from 71.4% in 2003, but lower than the peak of 81.1% in 2008.


